LEGAL NOTICE FOR PUBLIC HEARING & MEETING

A public hearing and meeting by the Old King's Highway Regional Historic District Commission will be held, in accordance with Chapter 470 of the Acts of 1973 (as amended), M.G.L.Ch. 138, Governor Baker's Executive Order of March 12, 2020 due to the current State of Emergency in the Commonwealth due to the outbreak of the "COVID-19 Virus" and the Sandwich Board of Selectmen's Open Meeting Law Declaration providing explanatory language on the use of Virtual Public Meetings conducted within the Town of Sandwich, will be conducted at **1:00 P.M. on Tuesday, October 20, 2020** to consider and act upon the following Appeal. The hearing and meeting will be convened **remotely via ZOOM video call** and broadcast live on SCTV at sandwichtv.org or on Sandwich Comcast Channel 15. No in person attendance of members of the public will be permitted

Appeal No. 2020 - 3 filed by Stephen Austin and Corinna M. Johnson seeking reversal of the Sandwich Town Committee's decision to grant a Certificate of Appropriateness (#20-29) to Peter and Cassie Lemire for construction of an addition to an existing shed located at 9 Brant Hill Road, Sandwich, Massachusetts. Said property being shown on Town Map 67 as Lot 16. The Sandwich Town Committee's decision was made on February 12, 2020 and notice filed with the Town Clerk on February 13, 2020. The Appeal Petition was filed on February 21, 2020 within the ten-day appeal period.

Public Comment in advance of the hearing may be submitted by written letter that is addressed to the Old King's Highway Regional Historic District Commission, Post Office Box 140, Barnstable, MA 02630-140. Said written letter must be received at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the hearing.
