### CAPE COD CANAL TO SERVICE ROAD CONNECTION

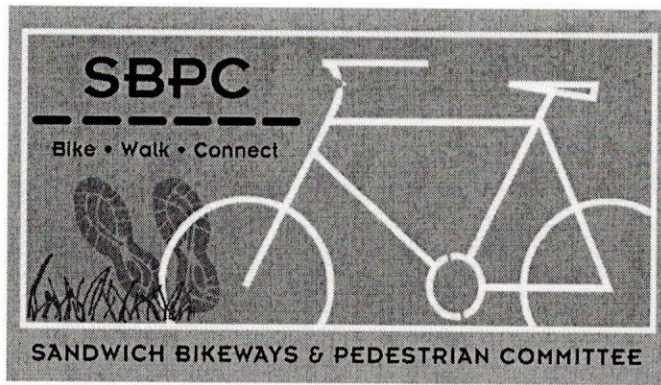
- Domigan provided summary of draft Mass Trails grant application, including map, for feasibility study of potential alternative routes to connect canal path to planned Service Road path. Jensen is filling in some blanks and will submit by Feb. 1.
- As a separate study, MassDOT will evaluate feasibility of alternatives routes for a multi-use path around the Route 6 Exit 2 interchange.
- Polay summarized letters of support for the Mass Trails grant; letter received from East Coast Greenway, and expected from Cape Cod NEMBA, Cape Cod Cycling Club, Cape Cod Commission, and Town of Bourne.
- Polay read draft letter of support from Committee to Bourne for its 2021 Mass Trails grant application for next phase of Bourne Rail Trail.
