### Free Family Outdoor Adventure Day

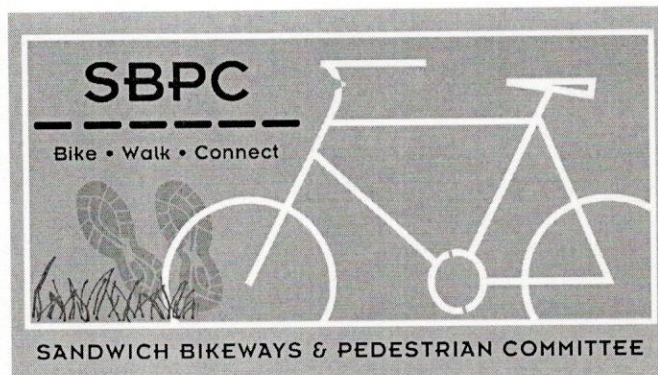
- Sandwich Recreation Department and Sandwich Partnership for Families are hosting an event on April 6, 1-4 p.m. Aim is to get folks out to visit with various entities promoting outdoor activities. Committee discussed whether to have our bike rodeo intersect, and consensus was to have a presence, and assess whether the event will work for the bike rode next year.

### Outreach

- MassBike Cape Cod Chapter Meeting
  - Rindfuss attended. 25-30 people there
  - Was a chapter years ago, but was a single person and withered.
  - This edition seems like it will be an energetic, robust group that will continue.
- Cape Cod Cycling Club monthly meeting
  - Rindfuss also attended. Asked them for future collaboration and assistance.
- Rails-to-Trails Conservancy
  - Webinar on trail branding and signage attended by a few committee members. Good ideas and reference materials for use once the Service Road and other trails are built.
- Friends of the Bourne Rail Trail
  - They featured us in a recent blog post based on questionnaire Polay filled out.



- Sandwich Chamber
  - Given their change in leadership, Polay resurfacing cycling article for their annual guide.
- League of American Cyclists
  - Rindfuss to ask about count of completed surveys, to see if it's worth another publicity push.

#### Master Plan

- Sandwich Police
  - Officer Brian Bondarek, though invited, did not attend the meeting.
  - Vitacco indicated that Mike Nurse writes the departmental grants, so he might be an additional contact for us for grant-related questions and activities.
- Non-Infrastructure Items
  - Rindfuss asked that committee members come to next meeting to discuss 1 or 2 infrastructure items to focus on.
  - Scott suggested walking and biking map
  - Polay discussed committee Web site to host maps
  - A progressive ticketing program (for both education and enforcement) by the police was also discussed.

#### Cotuit/Quaker Meetinghouse intersection

- Traffic study under way for Cotuit/Quaker and Quaker/Route 130 intersections.
- Traffic signals with emergency override included. Pedestrian connections too.

#### DPW Updates

- Tilton reported that Service Road path is close to 25% design submittal to MassDOT.
- That starts the review process that eventually will get us o 50, 75 and 100% complete. 25%, though, is a big chunk of the work.
- There will be a 25% design hearing as well
- Project is funded in 2022 TIP funds.
