**1. The meeting was brought to order by Rebecca Lovell Scott at 7:02 p.m.**

**2. Discussion & Update of COVID-19**

David Mason updated the Board on the Covid- 19 information he has received. He informed the Board of the status of the two positive cases in town. The Cape Emergency System set up a drive-up testing location at Cape Cod Community College. This facility requires a doctor's referral in order to be tested be sent to Cape Cod Hospital. The patient would then be assigned a time to arrive to be tested at no cost to them. The Board expressed concerns if the patient doesn't have health insurance and asked David to follow up on the protocol.

Mr. Mason gave the Board a copy of the order Governor Baker has put in place restricting gathering of 25 people or more on the premises for food or drink consumption. The Health Department issued an email to all the local restaurants a copy of the order. Any restaurant not in compliance with the order would be at risk of being closed per the Board of Health.

David Mason asked the Board to supply him their contact information in order for them to act during the pandemic if needed.

The Board was informed that as of this time, the daycares and Montessori schools were not under the Governor's orders to close. David Mason recommended they close in order to keep everyone safe. He also informed that Board that all town offices are closed to the public and that the town employees are still working.

**4. Review/Approval of Minutes**

A motion was made by Rebecca Lovell Scott to approve the minutes of the Board of Health Meeting from December 9, 2019 as written, seconded by Sandra Tompkins, and the motion passed with a vote of 3-0-0.
