Town Hall parking: Discussion continues on handicapped parking at the old town hall. Brendan has located the original plans and 2 accessible spaces on the Grove Street side of the hall were identified. There is a variance that the yellow lines are not allowed in the historic district. Research will continue and the assistant town manager is included in the communication. It was noted that up to 25% of Sandwich residents are identified having a disability.

The boardwalk application process is continuing.

Interpreters: The town has funds to paying for sign language interpreters for meetings and an account will be set up in the Planning and Development account. Handicapped parking fees: Taylor White has informed us that a fee for illegal parking in a handicapped space is \$100. Police Chief Wack is setting up a process so that fees will come to the Disability Commission. Taylor makes the decision who will be issued a ticket. We will discuss how we can assist the police at a later time. The three constables in town can also write up parking violations.

A vote was taken to not meet in the month of July.
