Meeting called to order by Rindfuss: 6:31 p.m.

MINUTES

- June 8, 2020 Minutes: Amendment to correct the year on the date. Approved unanimously by roll call vote.

SERVICE ROAD MULTI-USE PATH CONNECTIVITY

- Committee agreed that next step should be a feasibility study with community input
- Three options: Shawme/Heritage, Tupper/130, Charles St.
- Apply for MassTrails grant for fund study
- John Scott said he has been exploring way to connect Route 6A to Service Road entirely on state and public lands. He will present his findings at the next meeting.
- Goal would be to have feasibility study completed by the time shovels hit the ground for Service Road path

SERVICE ROAD PATH

- Jensen: Different groups within MassDOT working out what they're comfortable with for terminal end at Route 130
 - Complete Streets folks at MassDOT want to see it cross 130.
 - Others think crossing should be part of crossing of Route 6; look at it more holistically (separate project)

QMH/COTUIT

- Working with Stantec and Cape Cod Commission to try to secure funding
- Steve Tupper from Cape Cod Commission contacted the town regarding smaller scale projects (less than \$1 million) for which funding might be available. Town identified the two signals on Quaker to add a pedestrian phase and additional bike features. Hasn't





been designed yet. Concept only. But a possibility.

MAPLE SWAMP

- Boles: Town of Sandwich and NEMBA received \$5K grant to build a deck at high point in Maple Swamp (where there used to be a deck many years ago). Trail to the deck too. Within the last week the building permit was approved. Believe the trail has been laid out. Not sure if it has been walked with DNR for final OK. As soon as COVID-19 allows, Cape Cod NEMBA will build the deck and construct the trail.
- Marancik: Looking at September or early October. Town just has to inspect sonotubes for the footings. Once that's done, can begin the build.
- Recreation Department summer kids program had 24 riders. Planning fall program.

BIKE RACK PROGRAM

- Jensen: Application was approved. Put order in. Waiting for orders to arrive. Will do installation and get reimbursement from Cape Cod Commission.

DPW PROJECTS

- Jensen: Done with chip sealing for this year. John Ewer Road, Asa Meigs Road, and Cotuit Road scheduled for hot pavement mix.

ADAPTIVE SPORTS

- RIndfuss: Spaulding Rehabilitation Hospital hosting an adaptive mountain bike program on Saturdays at West Barnstable Conservation Area. Can't have volunteers now, but will in the future
- Marancik: Would really like to have that in Maple Swamp too.
